Your motion for admittance into the Community Service Labor Program (CSLP) or Drug Education Program (DEP) has been granted.

As a participant in the CSLP/DEP, you must successfully complete the following:

(1) Participate in the drug education classes that consist of **EIGHT (8)** classes once a week. The drug education aspect of this program consists of 12 hours of class work.

AND

(2) Perform 112 hours/32 hours community service at the Alternative Incarceration Center(AIC) location of your choice.

Both requirements must be completed as quickly as possible so your case can be dismissed. Successful completion of **both** components of the CSLP/DEP will result in a dismissal of the charge(s).

You are required to cooperate with the agency officials and it is necessary to keep all appointments. It is important that you notify the agency officials and this office if you change your address or if you are arrested on any new drug charges. All community service must be performed at the AIC serving your community. Any community service done outside of the AIC must be pre-approved by the AIC from a list they will provide you should you choose not to perform it through them. All community service must be reported back to the AIC for compliance and verification.

The provider of the drug education classes and the local AIC will be notified of your placement into the Community Service Labor Program/ Drug Education Program. If you have not been contacted by these agencies within one month from today, **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO CONTACT THE AGENCY IMMEDIATELY** at the number(s) provided on the back of this letter.

Failure to comply with these instructions will leave us with no other alternative than to recommend that your case be returned to court for non-compliance.
